As you may be aware of, the Albany Legislative sessions ended June 18<sup>th</sup>. We now will need to start the task of re-submitting our Cola, Health Protection and our Veterans Supplementation Bills for the upcoming 2017-2018 legislative sessions. On a positive note, Governor Cuomo finally signed the Veterans Bill for active police officers after vetoing the bill for the last two years. Senator Larkin, who sponsored the Active Officers and Retiree Officers Bill, has stated he will again sponsor our Retiree Veterans Bill. With Senator Larkin's active bill passed, it will hopefully help in getting the Retiree's Bill approved. It is very important that we do not become complacent regarding the lack of changes to our benefits because no changes have occurred yet. As you all are aware, the active rank unions do not represent retirees; the only voice we have as retirees is through the legislative process. Your National is proactive by having bills introduced, penning memoranda's of support, going to meetings with legislators and constantly making our concerns known. We will continue to work very closely with the Alliance of Public Retiree Organization of New York.
